



Surrender Fee Form

In order to prepare your surrendered pet for adoption, it will be microchipped, vaccinated, spayed or neutered, tested for leukemia, FIV, and heartworm for dogs while at the shelter. We do NOT euthanize for space, so your pet will stay here until it is adopted as long as it remains healthy and behaviorally sound.

Our adoption fee does not cover costs of readying animals to be adopted. These are the average costs of preparing our animals for adoption:

Male dog: \$184

Female dog: \$201

Male cat: \$140

Female cat \$155

We require a \$25 dollar fee for all surrenders however we encourage you to donate more:

Dog Surrender Form

Butte Humane Society Policy for owner-relinquished animals – The Butte Humane Society accepts owned animals from Chico City residents and may accept owned animals from Butte County residents on a space-available basis only. In relinquishing your animal to the Butte Humane Society you understand and agree to the following:

- 1) You are the legal owner of the animal you are relinquishing.
- 2) The Butte Humane Society will assess the physical and behavioral health of the animal to determine adoptability. The Butte Humane Society reserves the right to determine any animal's adoptability.
- 3) If you subsequently call about the animal's status, you may not be given any follow-up information about the animal except whether **it is** or **is not** at the shelter.

I, undersigned, owner or having control of the animal described below, hereby give ownership of said animal to the Butte Humane Society to be placed for adoption or humanely euthanized, at the discretion of the Society. I assume all responsibility for damages caused during my ownership of said animal. I agree to make all veterinarian records for said animal available to the Society and adopter of said animal.
